## HOW TO CORRECTLY FIT A DISPOSABLE MASK



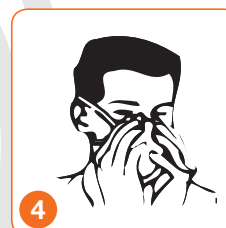
1 Hold respirator in hand with moulded nose contour (narrow end) at fingertips. Allow head-straps to hang below hand.



2 Place respirator against your face.



3 Place the top strap high on the back of your head. Move the bottom strap over your head and position it below your ears.



4 Use both hands to cup the respirator to the shape of your nose and face for a secure, comfortable fit.



5 Test the fit. Cup both hands over the respirator and exhale strongly. If airflows around your nose, tighten the nose-piece. If air escapes around the edges, reposition the straps for a better fit.

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
